ADVANTAGES OF EPD VERTICAL LIFT DOORS

Durable

Industrial, durable construction utilizing ASTM A36 structural steel framing, minimum 14 gauge flat hot rolled steel sheeting, and all exposed seams of the door panel sheeting are caulked with adhesive caulk after fabrication and prior to prime painting.

Vertical Lift steel doors are designed to work with large openings in abrasive operating conditions as well as extreme weather conditions, especially high wind loads.

It's well known that rubber and fabric materials deteriorate over time when exposed to ultraviolet rays of the sun, and extreme heat and cold temperatures. Additionally these materials don't possess the strength to withstand large wind loads, impact, or shearing.

Made of structural steel, EPD rigid door panels are designed not to bow, or deflect, or bind, and the guide systems always glide smoothly resulting in less operator wear.

Reliable

A common trouble spot for other large door types is a spring mechanism that operates a door, which is common on roll up doors. Springs suffer from spring fatigue and resulting failure. While the fatigue life of springs in other overhead door systems is often only 10,000 cycles, a vertical lift counter balanced operating system will have a 20 times longer life span than a spring operated system. That means a spring operated system will need to be repaired 20 times for every one time that a counter balanced system needs to be serviced.

The EPD counterbalance design applies even pressure on the counterweight box, which puts less pressure on the guides and less stress on the motor operator.

Quality

The extra thick cavity can accommodate more insulation to prevent energy loss including fibrous glass insulation, spray foam, or STC rated materials.
